INTRODUCTION TO YORK

York is a Walled City in Yorkshire, home to York Abbey, York Castle and The Dungeons. It has a great deal of tourist attractions within the city and will host this years meet.

With a mainline train station on the East Coast Main Line offering links to Birmingham, Bristol, Bournemouth, Cardiff, Chester, Holyhead, Manchester, York, Liverpool, Newcastle, Glasgow, Edinburgh and further. Airports include Leeds-Bradford, Manchester, Newcastle and Birmingham, all within approx 3 hours max. Hull Port is also within 1 hr and 5 minutes reach.

York has the National Rail Museum next door to the Train Station and it is here that we will have our meet this year.

TRAVEL AROUND YORK

If you are intending to visit the City Centre you can get a bus from the Station to the City Centre. Day tickets are available.

THE MEET:

The meet officially kicks off at 11:00 hrs – GMT+1 – at the NRM York. Badges will be given out by Andel to members on the day with their forum name and first name.

THE GAME

This year the game will be a Quiz sheet based in part on the NRM and on Transport Tycoon. The answers submitted will be considered and judge (Andel) decisions final. The prize will be a 1990s replica model of 153311 in Regional Railways blue/white on a plinth. No cash alternative is available.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

A wireless point will be available for people to play a pre-setup game on OpenTTD IS Beta 3 – West of England. The tracks will be pre-designed and the game will be for people to try and emulate the UK situation where possible.

Wifi will be available but it will be client isolated.
