LONDON

INTRODUCTION TO LONDON

London is a vibrant metropolis hosting many attractions and events. It is the home to the Queen (gawd bless her), The Routemaster, The Tube, Tower Bridge and The Tate Gallery.

With mainline train stations offering links to Birmingham, Bristol, Bournemouth, Cardiff, Chester, Holyhead, Manchester, York, Liverpool, Newcastle, Glasgow, Edinburgh and more, 5 international airports from just 30 minutes away and a time to Birmingham of 1hr 45minutes, connections are fast and frequent.

London has two key points that will affect the meet – Leicester Square and Covent Garden – both are within 15 minutes walk of each other.

THE GEOGRAPHY

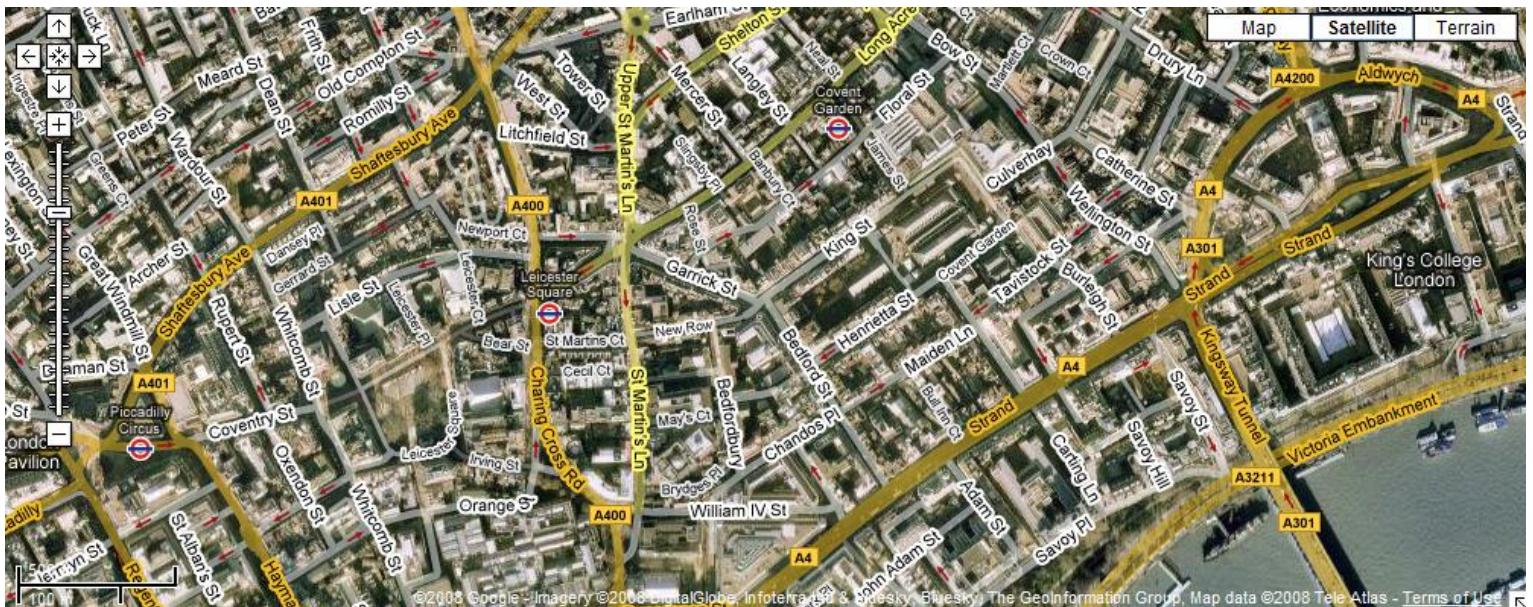

TRAVEL AROUND LONDON

We have evaluated the many ways that people will travel to the meet and know that many if not all will use public transport. We strongly recommend purchasing a Zone 1-2 travel card for the day. We also recommend checking on the National Rail Website (www.nationalrail.co.uk) for any diversions or closures on the day.

An Oyster Card is a good way to get about London – be aware that PAYG oyster is not always valid on National Rail services and it is advisable to check beforehand.

THE MEET:

The meet officially kicks off at 11:00 hrs – GMT+1 – at Leicester Square, London. Badges will be given out by Andel to members on the day with their forum name, real first name, a TT-forums logo and a country flag. Some badges may have a caption beneath them. Organisers will be wearing recognisable shirts and/or badges.

GENERAL HEALTH AND SAFETY:

On the day a First Aid Kit will be with Andel or if he is off-site, Dave Worley or Owen Rudge. It is encouraged that you try to avoid injury as Andel has not opened this kit and would like to return it on Monday to Boots.

We encourage you to know where the main organisers are at all times. During the game, make sure you get one of your companions or team-leaders mobile phone number. Should you lose your team during the game and you cannot get contact with your team-mates, make your way back to Leicester Square.

THE GAME – THINGS TO NOTE:

We encourage you to read the ATOC guidelines issued to each team, as well as using general common sense when out travelling around London. Team Leaders are instructed that should they feel the personal safety of the team is threatened, to instruct the person to leave the meet and if need be follow alternative game instructions.

In event of a security alert, please follow the instructions given by Transport for London staff. Do not make your way back to Leicester Square until given the all clear to use the tube or buses.

We will also be issuing maps of the Tube and OverGround network to each team.

THE GAME – AT STATIONS:

You will be expected to sign in at the Network Rail reception of each station before taking photographs. Steps have been taken to alert as many stations as possible but we were unable to make arrangements with London Bridge, Victoria or St Pancras. Please try to obtain permissions but if it is refused please see your team leader for a plan B. Please do not be abusive or rude to any station staff as we have worked hard to obtain permissions to use major stations as part of the game. Should there be any issues the team leaders will have direct contact with Andel/Dominic Lund-Conlon.
